 - One bill was paid to Fletcher and Tilton for \$364 for consult on GEIA Property line.

1. 2025 Pre-Treatment Survey Results

The survey was conducted on May 29 by Water and Wetlands and showed minimal growth of milfoil in the north end, and some fanwort popping up. Many members are now seeing a lot more growth so Jackie will ask them to come back to assess.

2. GEIA Property Update

- i. Mulch - property still awaiting mulch
- ii. Plaques
 - Steve Schur requested \$50.00 to purchase a cedar post for the Eagle Scout Plaque. Jackie has received some responses authorizing names to be placed on the Memorial Post. Steve will finalize with Guertins so these can be installed.
- iii. Trees
 - Frank Zapulla will proceed to get three quotes to remove several trees and limbs from the property.
- iv. Drainage plans
 - Paul McManus is still working on it. Goal is to have this included on the existing NOI and complete the work Fall 2025.
- v. Frank asked if there is any update on the property line adjacent to the Lefebvre property. Jackie reported the lawyers are still working on it.
